FIRE SAFETY TIPS FOR THE HOLIDAYS

In the midst of celebrations, no matter how small, you should always keep safety top of mind. Here are a few tips that will help you enjoy a hazard-free holiday.

- 1. Choose carefully. You've got to pick the right tree and the right lights or how and where you plan to use them. Artificial trees should ideally be fire resistant, and lights compatible for indoor or outdoor use. Read labels to make sure all your decorations are up to code.
- Check cords. If strings of lights are frayed or the bulbs have loose connections, it's best to replace them. Invest in a surge protector for your tree as well.
- 3. **Be vigilant.** Candles undoubtedly add to the Christmas atmosphere, but don't place them in positions where they can set anything alight or leave them unattended areas or within reach of children. The same goes for cooking, by the way keep an eye on the stove and be sure to extinguish all candles and unplug all lights and turn off all burners before leaving the house or going to bed.
- Use common sense. When hanging lights outdoors, for instance, never secure them in place with anything that can puncture or compromise the electrical cords.
- 5. Do the right thing. Quite apart from the havoc that fireworks wreak on children, the elderly, those with sensory issues, animals and wildlife, it is against the law to set off fireworks in any town in Trinidad and Tobago without a permit. If improperly discharged, fireworks can pose a serious risk of both fire and projectile injury.
